2	Discussion and comments of draft Comprehensive Area Assessment Report The draft CAA report was broadly welcomed as providing a balanced and generally accurate picture of Peterborough. The main areas of concern were the red flag for crime and the comments on education, which were based on data for 2008, not the improved results of 2009. After discussion it was agreed not to challenge the red flag for crime and to use our own communication work to ensure that the public were clear about the improved education results in 2009. The group discussed each section of the report in detail. It was decided that each member of the committee should make their track changes in the document and submit to Christina Wells by 30 October 2009 It was agreed to establish a communications group, led by Richard Astle, to co-ordinate our response to the publication of the CAA report, currently scheduled for 10 December.
