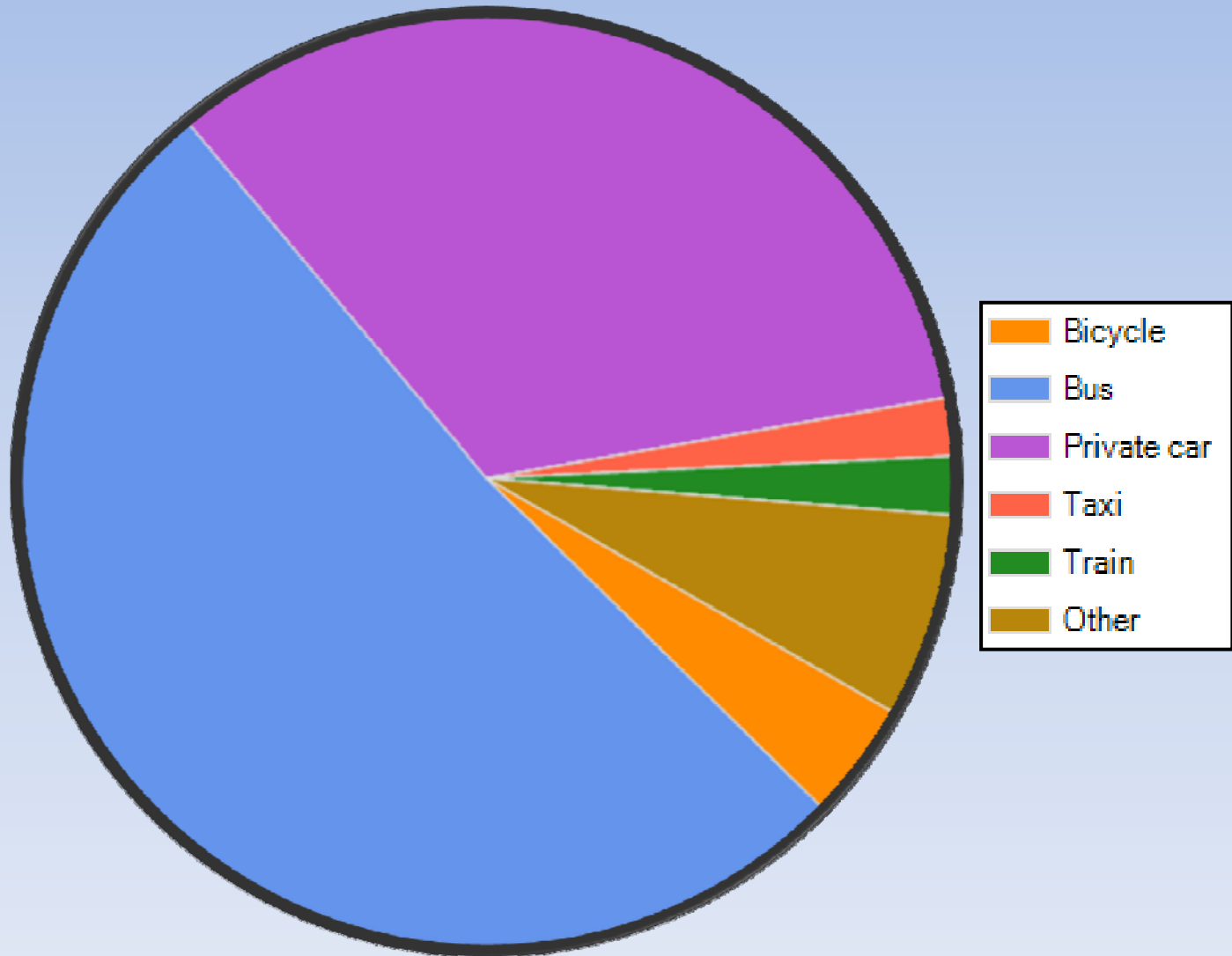

- Better and more cycle routes





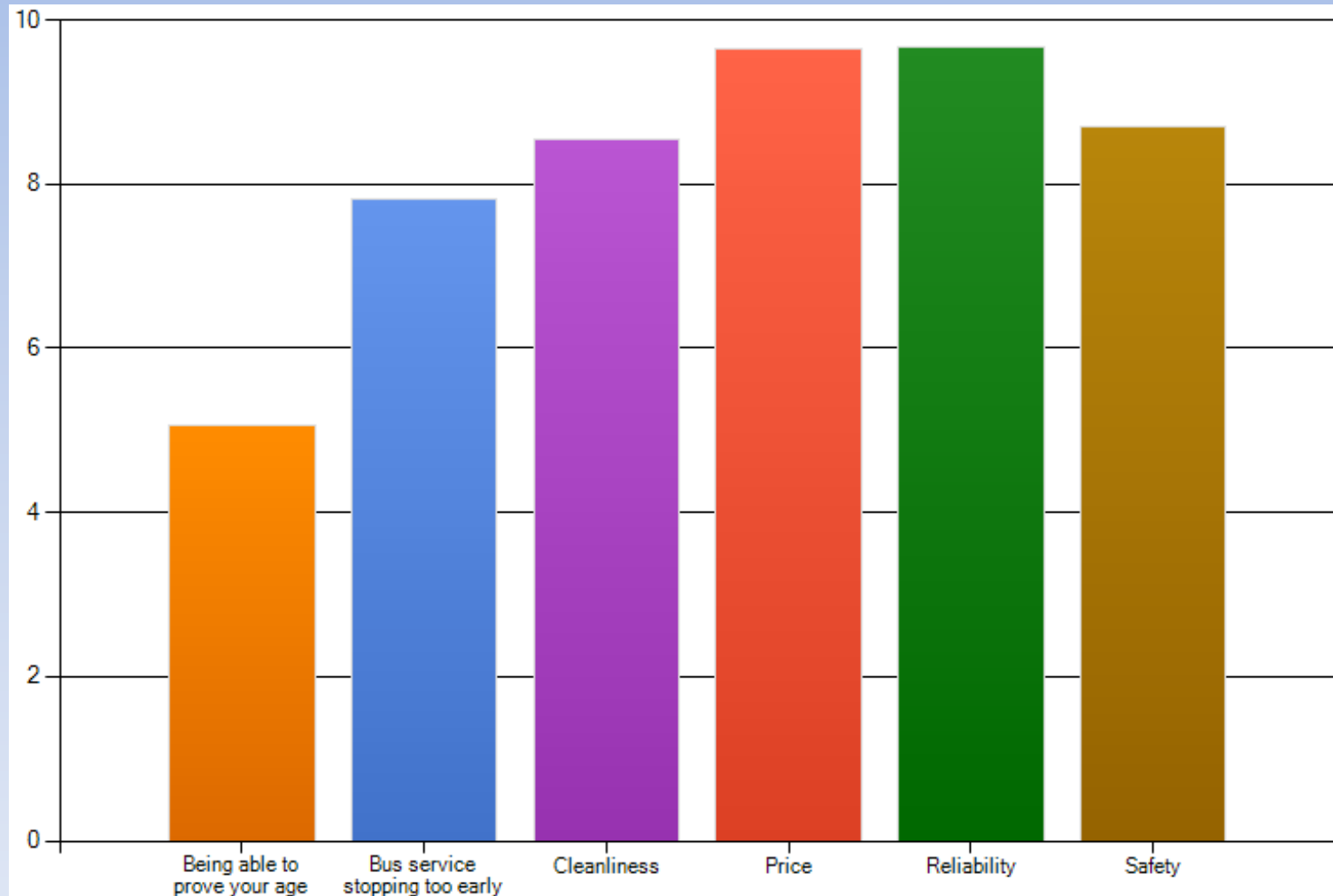

How important are each of these aspects of bus travel to you?

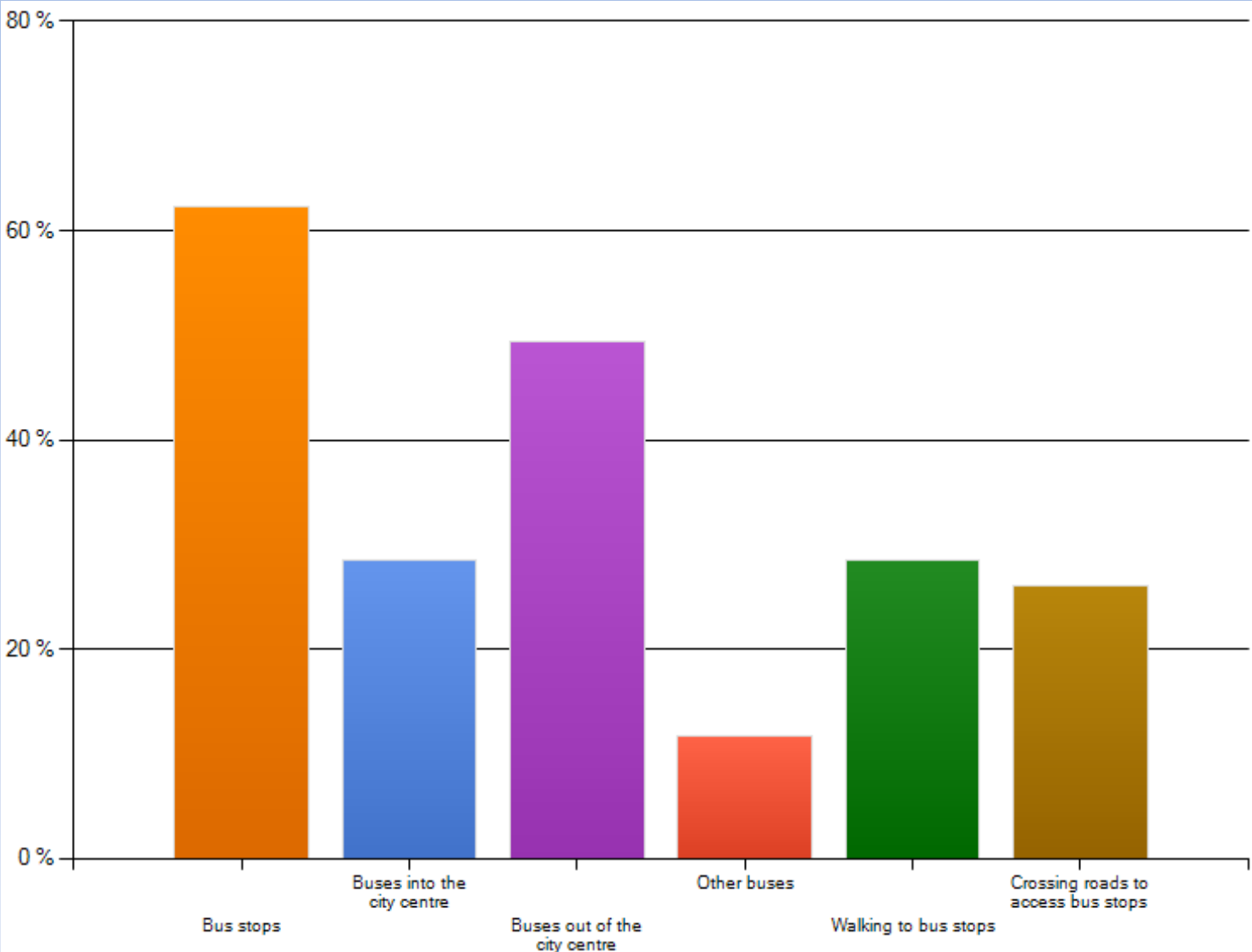
("10" is very important, "0" is unimportant)



Reducing the cost of bus fare

- 92.6% agree free bus travel will help achieve Peterborough becoming the UK's Environment Capital
- 64.6% would use buses more if they were 20% cheaper
- 71.3% think cheaper bus fares should be the Peterborough Youth Council's main priority
