Social Responsibility Committee for Peterborough Renewable Energy's proposed Energypark

The Energypark will be situated on land at Storeys Bar Road in Peterborough and will process up to 650,000 tonnes of waste per annum using innovative technology. The SRC will play a key role in ensuring its safe operation.

The purpose of the committee is

- to scrutinise the implementation and management of Peterborough Renewable Energy's environmental management system
- to oversee PREL's compliance with applicable environmental and health & safety legislation
- to assure independent evaluation of the company's environmental and health & safety performance
- to administer PREL's Community Cohesion Fund

The SRC will consist of two representatives from PREL, two from local waste group Peterborough for Responsible Waste Management, two from the local business community and four from local community groups. Meetings are expected to be held monthly initially and thereafter at two monthly intervals, with occasional additional meetings.

Representation on the SRC is an excellent example of the kind of active citizenship currently being encouraged by the RSA Citizen Power project. It also provides an opportunity to demonstrate support for Peterborough's Environment Capital aspiration.

Leaders of local business groups are invited to nominate suitable persons, who may be either active or retired/semi-retired business persons, to serve on the committee.
